Rope Access

Historically provision of access formed a disproportionate part of the total cost of many inspection and minor repair operations. The use of industrial rope techniques (abseiling) leaves few surfaces which cannot be quickly and cheaply accessed for inspection, testing and maintenance purposes.

Rope access is ideal in situations where small amounts of work must be conducted at scattered locations or where installation of a gondola/cradle or the use of a mobile access platform would be difficult or impossible. Typical applications include :-

- routine condition assessments
- sampling and in-situ testing
- failure investigations
- hose testing of facades
- leak testing/location and repair
- external 'hands on' inspections
- installation of instrumentation
